STALLION CONTRACT FOR TRANSPORTED SEMEN DELIVERY

This contract hereby confirms the reservation to the Morgan stallion WINTERGREEN BEAUFORT #164146 for the year 2022. This breeding contract is between the stallion owner and the mare owner. Woodland Stallion Station is ONLY responsible for fulfilling the service. The following terms are understood and accepted:

1. A veterinary certificates showing the mare to be in sound breeding condition and free of infection (not necessary if she is a maiden mare).

2. The following fees must be paid to Woodland Stallion Station **before the delivery** of the live semen:

3. WOODLAND STALLION STATION assumes responsibility only to deliver live semen in viable condition at the time of delivery to the mare owner's farm or veterinarian, the semen must be administered on **the day of delivery** or the STALLION STATION shall not be responsible for any further contractual obligations. STALLION STATION MUST BE NOTIFIED 48 HOURS IN ADVANCE OF A NEED FOR A SHIPMENT.

4. There will be a collection fee of \$200 for each shipment (mare owner's responsibility). If the mare does not conceive after two heat cycles, it is mandatory that the mare be biopsied to determine more fully her breeding condition.

If the mare does not deliver a live foal, one that stands and nurses, there will be return privileges in the following year only. The mare owner will be responsible for collection and shipping costs. In case it is found that the above mare is determined not breedable by a licensed veterinarian, another mare may be substituted with the approval of the stallion owner.

This contract is a contract between the stallion owner and the mare owner. The stallion owner will be responsible for collection and shipments after the year 2022 if the stallion is not standing at Woodland Stallion Station. If the stallion dies or becomes sterile before the completion of this contract, the stallion owner will not be responsible for refunds on any expenses and all monies due for collection and shipment must be paid by the mare owner.

5. If the mare is sold, this contract is null and void. Breeding dates the stallion will be available are between February 1 and September 30, 2022. Woodland Stallion Station must be given every opportunity to fulfill the contract.

6. All shipping and collection costs will be billed to and paid by the mare owner prior to the signing of the breeding certificate.

7. IT IS UNDERSTOOD THAT THE MARE MUST BE EXAMINED BY A LICENSED VETERINARIAN BETWEEN 14 AND 18 DAYS AND AGAIN BETWEEN 24 AND 30 DAYS AFTER THE LAST DAY BRED AND THE STALLION STATION NOTIFIED OF HER PREGNANCY AT THAT TIME OR THE CONTRACT IS NULL AND VOID.

8. It is understood that all of the above results must be in writing and that the MARE'S BREEDING PASSPORT (sent with the first semen shipment) must be signed and returned to the Stallion Station within 10 days of the second examination. A copy of the mare's registration papers must be attached to this contract.

9. If the mare aborts, proof in writing from a Licensed veterinarian must be presented to show that the mare has been vaccinated on a regular schedule with Pneumabort K and that she has been well cared for, or the live foal guarantee is void.

10. It is understood that the mare owner shall assume all responsibility for the condition of the mare and shall bear all risk of loss or damage to the mare whether by death, disease, injury, infection or otherwise, and by any cause whatsoever, and therefore agrees to hold the stallion owner and the WOODLAND STALLION STATION, or any person employed by or associated with the stallion owner or WOODLAND STALLION STATION harmless for any and all damages associated therewith.

11. In the event of any litigation arising out of this agreement, the prevailing parties shall be entitled to a reasonable sum as and for his attorney's fees. Any controversy between the parties hereto involving the construction or application of any of the terms, covenants,

or conditions of the agreement, shall upon written request of one party served on the other be submitted to arbitration and such arbitration shall comply with and be governed by the provisions of the California Arbitration Act, Section 1280 through 1294.2 of the California Code of Civil Procedure.
